### **Day Three Training** **How to make the most of it**

eDOCSNL Program implementation includes a “Day 3” training day facilitated by a TELUS Health Learning Specialist. This is a full-day component of the EMR on-boarding process that is scheduled for 4-6 weeks after you ‘go live.’

While the training is mandatory and requires your clinic to be closed for an additional day, “Day 3” training is an opportunity to solidify competencies in using the software and to support more advanced and mature use of the available features and standardized provincial clinical content.

The day can be uniquely customized to meet your clinic’s needs and should include both providers and support staff. Typically, the first half of the day is comprised of a question and answer session to address issues, questions or challenges that may have come up during your first 4-6 weeks with Med Access. The second half of the day is typically spent introducing more advanced content. For example, “Day 3” may cover the new chronic disease tools developed by eDOCSNL such as care plans, flowsheets and

dashboards for the care of patients with diabetes, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and hypertension. eDOCSNL Practice Advisors may also suggest items relevant to your practice and patient population.

## HEALTHe NL Reminder The provincial EHR is accessible to all eDOCSNL users

The provincial electronic health record, HEALTHe NL, is a tool accessible to all eDOCSNL users when working with a patient. HEALTHe NL can be launched directly from Med Access providing you with additional patient information such as a medication profile.

Did you know that you can also log into HEALTHe NL outside of the Med Access EMR? This could be beneficial if you find yourself working outside of your normal clinical setting, or are looking for quick access to patient information. Most eDOCSNL users already have HEALTHe NL log-in credentials.
