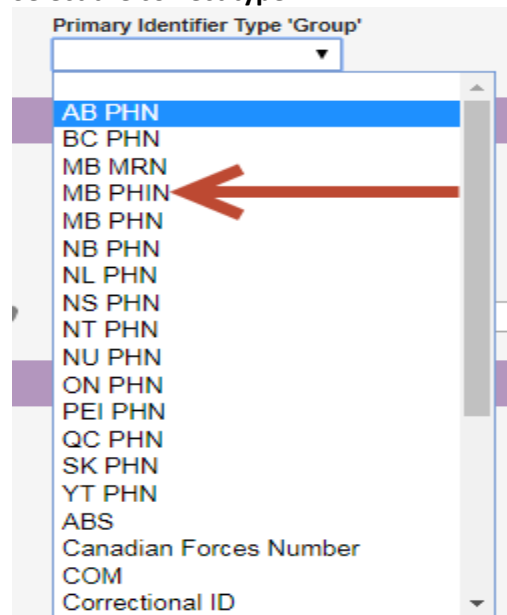


MCP Billing for Manitoba (MB) Patients

When adding Manitoba Health Cards to the patients chart in EMR, it's the 9 digit individual number that needs to be set up as **MB PHIN** in the patient demographics and be the lowest sort order (ie: 0 or 1). When creating the bill you need to ensure it's the **MB PHIN** that is set in the Insurer drop down of the bill window.

NOTE: If you want to record the 6 digit family number in the char it should be set as the **MB PHN** and needs to be a higher sort number in the Identifier List (ie: 40 or 50).

Select the correct type – MB PHIN



Select 'Identifier List', select EDIT icon to the far right and ensure *Priority is 1 or 0* - **SAVE**
