

EMR vs SEINET

Entering Depot Information

Regional depots receive vaccine from the government depot and then distribute it to sites within their catchment area. In previous flu seasons, the following information was recorded in Vaccine Management for all immunizations:

- Select the regional depot from where the vaccine originated (e.g. MPS Depot)
- Select the Program administering the vaccine (e.g. Public Health)
- Select what site the vaccine was stored (e.g. MPS (site))
