In the coming days, eleven of these triggers will be introduced to all provincial EMR instances.

About CDS Triggers

The Provincial EMR CDS triggers are evidence-based assistive alerts for clinicians that have been developed for population-based screening procedures.

CDS Triggers are population-based reminders applied to all patient charts based on defined criteria which will display on the patient's record as:

This 18+ year old patient has not had a BP reading in the last year

These alerts will disappear once the trigger has been actioned and will re-appear when needed. The absence of the alert means the screening maneuver has been completed, whereas seeing the alert means action is needed!
