Med Access: Documentation for Immunization Not Administered

Documentation for Immunization not Administered

1. If through the screening process immunization is contraindicated and/or immunization is not administered, select **'No'** or **'Contraindicated'**. The options will be dependent upon the consent template used.
2. If immunization is not administered, document the reason as to why. It can be documented within the available textbox OR within the observations field, depending upon template of consent.
3. The vaccine administration fields **must be left blank**.
4. Click **Save** to close the task.
