



BCM BILLING: SUPERVISING A LEARNER

According to section 3.7 c) of Schedule R of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), the Blended physicians who supervise learners will be paid 100% for their fee-for-service claims. A learner is defined as a resident or medical student.

Bills can be created in a Pending status by the resident learner under the supervising provider to gain experience in billing. The learner will not approve the bill. The provider and/or clerical who approve the billing of a patient who is rostered to Blended Capitation will need to select "5 - Learner Student Supervision (Blended Capitation)" under the **Provider Capacity** pull-down field in the billing window:



This selection under the **Provider Capacity** field will remove the BCM check mark from the bill and allow the unit field to calculate at 100% payment of the Fee Code:



The bills can then be approved. If the Provider Capacity field of "5 - Learner Student Supervision (Blended Capitation)" is not selected, the bill will be approved at the Blended Capitation rate of 25% of the fee code unit price.
