Telus is moving EMR data to the cloud to enable the EMR data extract. Click here for more details. The existing agreement requires revision as it explicitly states the storage locations for EMR data. Additional changes have been made to the agreement to reduce the frequency with which you'll need to re-sign in the future. This is a summary of the changes :



EMR Data will be Transitioning to the Cloud

- All references to data centre locations have been removed.
- Clinical data will now be housed in AWS cloud services within Canada.



Removal of Redundant Terms

 Redundancy and specific references such as to systems and vendors have been removed.



Overlap with Telus Contract Eliminated

- Duplication between the Physician Agreement and the contract with Telus is being eliminated.
- This would include the specifics of EMR support services, which are included in the Telus contract with NLCHI, attached to the physician agreement when signed by the physician.



Since the EMR data must move to facilitate the extract, the program will provide a transition pathway from the program to those who decline to sign. The agreement and amendment will still be valid following the NLCHI transition into the Provincial Health Authority.
