

Your eResults Are Changing

As Newfoundland and Labrador Health Services transitions to CorCare, the new provincial Health Information System, providers will notice a change in the way some of their eResults look. In the coming weeks, eResults subscriptions will be changing from the current Meditech-based results to the CorCare-based results. Both types of results will be seen in the EMR for the first couple of weeks after launch (April 25, 2026). Both types of results will continue to populate results in your EMR.

To ensure the continuation of eResults delivery in an effective and seamless manner, the eDOCSNL Program will be validating results for all providers continuing in EMR. eDOCSNL staff may request access to your instances, if necessary, to complete these checks.

Specific eResults Changes

While many results will have a similar look and feel to your current results, there are some notable changes. Specific changes to each category of results are noted below.

Clinical Documents

Consults will now cover a broader range of documents known as clinical documents. Clinical documents may include additional items such as discharge summaries (this is currently only an option for the inpatient setting), procedure notes and advanced care planning notes. These documents would be included in a primary results subscription if the provider is listed in CorCare as the primary care provider. To see these documents, click the attachment symbol.

Labs

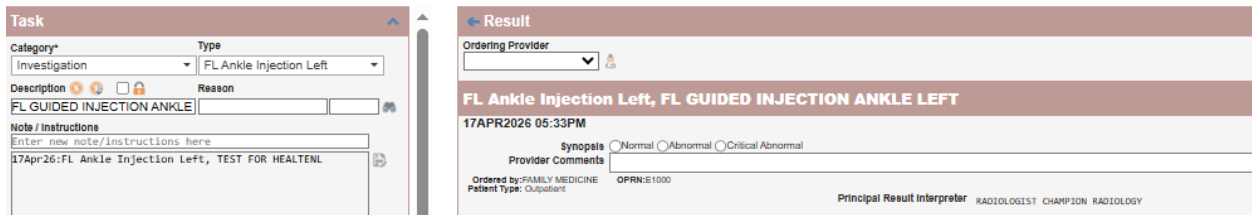
Many labs will look the same; however, there is a difference in that more labs have an attachment icon, which will provide you with additional information. In addition, if there have been addendums you may see that results now appear as corrected.

Corrected [attachment icon]

An example of a lab with attachment is a pap smear result. Some information may be visible in the task, but the attached report will have more detail.

Diagnostic Imaging

Imaging results will remain largely unchanged; however, it should be noted that results may have the title repeated. This is expected.
